Reports from working groups:

- Electric Highway no progress to report.
- Information/Strategy/Brochure group Has had its first meeting, will concentrate first on a brochure for caravan parks, since these should require almost no further infrastructure. This will be a three fold A4 brochure. Shayn offered the contact details for a local printer who is good at small runs.
- Bus group has not met.
- National Website Charles is meeting up with the others on this group at Adelaide AGM.
- Tas Networks Pricing Reform Working Group Penny Cocker attended the first guarterly

meeting in September. This was an introductory meeting, Tas Networks is taking a gentle approach to the process of changing tariffs.

Destination Chargers:

Currently 37 shown on <u>Plugshare.com</u> for Tas (up from 26 last month). Can we get 50 before Christmas?

Caravan park chain "Discovery" has agreed to allow charging at all their parks. See PlugShare for details.

Gowrie Park Wilderness Village have agreed to allow charging. Details not yet finalised. Highland Cabins at Bronte Park are now on PlugShare with two Tesla chargers and a wall outlet.

John Casimaty mentioned that he visited PumpHouse Point and used their Tesla charger, but it didn't charge at the advertised rate.

Upcoming dates:

- AGM in Adelaide 21st, 22nd, 23rd October.
 - Clive, Michael W & Christopher are our delegates, Penny W and Charles are also going. Clive (Leaf) and the Wadsleys (Outlander) are taking their cars. Clive has found that there are caravan parks at suitable intervals along the way, and he will ask if he can add them to the PlugShare map. Since Clive will have ample downtime along the way he has contacted 14 local newspapers en route, inviting them to interview him as he travels.
- Sustainable Living Festival (Hobart) 12th & 13th November.
 - Please contact Clive (or the secretary) if you'd like to volunteer some time over the two days. Clive has divided each day into three two hour slots, and would like three volunteers at a time. There will be space for four cars outside, we'd like four different models such as Outlander, i3, iMiEV, conversion. There will be a Leaf and a Tesla inside, so not those makes in the outside display. Michael offered his Outlander (it holds up the banner!) and Penny hopes that Warren's conversion will be available. Rhys will discuss with Clive whether and when he might be able to lend his i3. So we need to find an iMiEV, or some other model (a Volt or a motorbike perhaops, or the RACT charging trailer). Tesla has a booth, as does the Electric Horseman (custom electric motorbikes).
